‘WHO’ defines “acute diarrhoea” as an attack of sudden onset, which usually last 3 – 7 days but may last up to 10 – 14 days.

Presenting symptomatology is –

- ❖ Ac. Diarrhoea
- ❖ Abd. Cramps
- ❖ Dehydration
- ❖ Vomiting
- ❖ Weakness

Systemic symptoms are –

- Fever
- Malaise
- Seizures

Factors that increases susceptibility to infection with antro pathogens include young age, immune deficiency, measles, malnutrition, travel to an endemic area, lack of breast feeding exposure to unsanitary conditions, indigestion of contaminated water, food, level of material education & child-care-center attendance.

These clinical conditions can be very nicely dealt with Homoeopathy, with life saving general management of patient.

Complications of ACUTE GASTROENTERITIS:

- Hypovolumic Shock

Homoeopathy Approach

Review of Literature

1. Diarrhoea is a major public health problem in developing countries.
2. Diarrhoea is almost universally infections in origin.
3. Diarrhoea disease causes a heavy economic burden on health services. Much attention given to the acute Diarrhoea & its management over the last decade which is dominated by advances in oral re-hydration techniques.

A recent report Oral re-hydration therapy may now be preventing about 3 million dehydration death in a year.

WHO – Acute dehydration is revealed in importance only by /respiratory infection, as a cause of morbidity on a world wide scale.

WHO initiated Diarrhoeal Disease control program in 1980.

Approx – 4-6 million children were dying each year of the dehydration.

By this ratio is prevented about 3 million dehydration death in a year.
